Sandakan Day Trip

- Pick up at Sepilok B&B

Sandakan Memorial Park - This park is dedicated to the memory of the prisoners of war who died during World War II in Sandakan. You can learn about the history and significance of this somber site.

St. Michael's Church - St. Michael's Church is a famous Gothic-Romanesque Catholic church in Sandakan, Malaysia, built-in 1893. It's a significant landmark and tourist attraction, accommodating up to 800 worshippers.

Balin Roofgarden Bistro & Bar - This rooftop restaurant and bar offers a breathtaking view of Sandakan Bay while you enjoy delicious food and drinks

Seafood Restaurant - Sandakan is well-known for its delicious seafood, and the seafood restaurant option is a perfect opportunity to experience it. There are many seafood restaurants in Sandakan that offer fresh seafood, including lobsters, crabs, prawns, and fish

Proboscis Monkey

- Pick up 40-50 mins before feeding time
- 25 minutes away by car to Labuk Bay Proboscis Monkey Sanctuary
- On-site ticket purchase

The driver will take you to Platform A/B for the first feeding. Following the first feeding, the driver will take you to the next platform B or A for the second feeding. Alternatively, you may choose to skip the next feeding.

NOTE:

Grab (e-hailing) can send you there but it may be difficult to get transportation out as it is a secluded area.

Walking to the platforms from the ticketing counter and from platform to platform is not advisable especially if you have heavy bags or cameras due to the distance.
